## SMALL MINES AND FUTURE TECHNIQUES<sup>1</sup>

<u>Abstract</u>. Many of the remaining surface mineable coal reserves in the Midwest are located in small noncontinuous areas ("pods"). It will take innovative approaches that incorporate many factors in order to economically recover these resources, while still providing for proper reclamation. Some of these factors include planning for:

(1) property control;

(2) the permitting process with regards to soil handling, land uses, drainage control, and blending with undisturbed areas; and

(3) development of engineering plans that incorporate the overall reclamation requirements and flexibility/understanding of the regulatory agencies.
