Abstract: The Quapaw Nation was the first tribe to conduct superfund remediation in the United States. The 15-20 minute video will show superfund remediation work being conducted at the Tar Creek Superfund Site in Northeast Oklahoma. Video will show a fifteen-acre project from start to finish, including clearing vegetation, removing hazardous source material, grading the site, water management, capping mineshafts, soil sampling, and revegetation.
