<u>Video Abstract:</u> Soil salinity is an issue facing a majority of agricultural producers in North Dakota. In most cases, portions of the fields affected by soluble salts can no longer produce annual crops grown in the region and are remediated using cover crops or perennial species. Cover crop mixes and establishment of alfalfa used for remediation at the Sargent County, ND Salinity Demonstration Site are show in Parts 1 and 3 of this video series.
