Abstract: Highlight work conducted by the Quapaw Nation on superfund remediation work ongoing at the Tar Creek Superfund Site in Northeast Oklahoma, including project successes and failures. Restoration tools at remediation projects expands with every project completed, and now includes use of new technologies at the site to save clean soils, native vegetation, composting for soil reclamation, and future watershed revegetation.
