



Call for Workshops and Special Sessions

The 43rd Annual Meeting of the American Society of Reclamation Sciences

Laramie, WY

June 7 through 11, 2026

ASRS members and non-members are invited to submit proposals for workshops and special sessions at our 2026 annual meeting in Laramie, Wyoming. Workshops will be conducted on Sunday, June 7, 2026 and can be half-day or full-day in length. Workshops should begin Sunday morning, but exceptions for Sunday afternoon preference may be given.

Special sessions, which will be scheduled as part of the Technical Sessions, will happen Monday, June 8, through Wednesday, June 10. Half-day (6 papers) or quarter-day (3 papers) session proposals are invited.

The proposal deadline for workshops and special sessions is October 5, 2025.

Proposals will be evaluated by the Laramie Annual Meeting Planning Committee and should include a justification for the proposed workshop or special session, target audience, and proposed agenda with tentative speakers. If selected, special sessions will be included in the Call for Abstracts to target potential additional speakers for those specific topics. Workshop and special session organizers are encouraged to consider a write-up or publication in ASRS's <u>Journal of Reclamation Science</u> or its biannual magazine, <u>Reclamation Matters</u>, after the annual meeting. Proposals may include a suggested approach for a publication resulting from the workshop or special session, if selected.

Workshops must have a minimum of ten attendees to be self-sustaining. No supplementary funding is available through the overall annual meeting budget or ASRS itself. Beverages will be supplied by the Rochelle Center on Sunday for workshop attendees. Lunch and snacks may be provided based on workshop attendance. Workshop and special session proposals should be submitted using the form linked below to the Laramie Planning Committee by October 5, 2025.
